AGENDA ITEM NO. 1: Call to Order.

The Mayor called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

AGENDA ITEM NO. 2: Invocation.

The invocation was given by Councilman Singer.

AGENDA ITEM NO. 3: Recognition of Special Guest(s)/Action(s).

The Mayor recognized Police K-9 Officer Jimmy Skinner and K-9 dog Arno for their recent success placing second in Narcotics Detection at a United States Police Canine Association, Region 25 competition in Abilene, Texas. Officer Skinner and Arno certified with the United States Police Canine Association, Inc. and the National Police Canine Association.

AGENDA ITEM NO. 4: Citizens' Input.

Mr. Steve Smith, owner of Ken's Pizza, asked the Council if he could obtain additional right-of-way on the north side of Ken's. The City recently abandoned this right-of-way. The City Manager stated he would look into the possibility and report back to the Council.

AGENDA ITEM NO. 5: General Consent.

- A. Approval and Acceptance of the Minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting of April 12, 2010.
- B. Approve the Request From the Hotter-N-Hell Hundred Organization to Use the City Hall Park and restroom as the Location for Their First Rest Stop for Their Annual Bicycle Ride to be Held Saturday, August 28, 2010.

AGENDA ITEM NO. 6: Proclamation.

- A. A Proclamation of the Mayor of the City of Iowa Park, Texas, Proclaiming the Week of May 9-15, 2010 as National Police Week.

The Mayor read the proclamation proclaiming the week of May 9-15, 2010 as Nation Police Week and presented the proclamation to the Chief of Police and officers present.

AGENDA ITEM NO. 7: City Manager's Report.

- A. Discuss and Consider Establishing Dates and Times for the Operation Hours of the Iowa Park Municipal Pool and Spray Park as Well as User Fees of Said Pool and Park for the 2010 Swim Season.

It was noted the proposed fees and hours are the same as the 2009 swim season. The only change is for the new pavilion that can be reserved for daytime parties. Daytime semi-private party fee is \$30.00 per event while daytime private party fee is \$50.00 per event. The opening date is set for Saturday, May 29, 2010 and closing for the season on Sunday, August 22, 2010. Fees for the 2010 season are as follows:

Daily entrance fee - \$2.50 per person

Individual season pass - \$50.00 per person

Group season pass

2 person - \$95.00 3 person - \$130.00 4 person - \$155.00 5 person - \$180.00

6 person - \$205.00 For every person over 6 add \$35.00 per person

Hours of operation will be Monday and Wednesday thru Saturday 12:00 noon to 6:00 p.m.

Tuesday from 12:00 noon to 8:30 p.m. with no after hour parties

Sunday from 1:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

After hours semi-private party fee - \$125.00 per event - private party fee - \$200.00 per event

After hours for semi-and private party hours will be from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.

- B. Discuss and Consider Setting a Time and Location to Conduct the City's Annual Goal Setting Retreat/Workshop.

After a brief discussion, it was the consensus of the Council to hold the annual goal setting retreat/workshop on Saturday, June 5, 2010, starting at 9:00 a.m. at the Gun Club, if available.

It was noted there will need to be a special City Council meeting on Monday, May 17 to canvass the May 8th election.
